Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 58 calls during the month of June. The breakdown is as follows:

Nine Fire Calls:

- seven in the Village fire alarm activation at Absolut Care, 26 Cass Street; smoke alarm activation from burnt food at 83 Spring Street; transformer fire at Cottage and Spring Streets; fire alarm activation due to A/C unit malfunction at Welch Office Building, 2 South Portage Street; fire alarm activation at 79 Jefferson Street; vehicle fire at North Portage and Hawley Streets; and a dumpster fire at Holiday Motel, 223 North Portage Street; and
- two on the NYS Thruway a passenger bus fire at mile marker 477.3 eastbound; and a care fire at mile marker 488.3 westbound.
- 46 EMS Calls: 15 in the Village; 11 in the Town*; 18 at Absolut Care; and two Mutual Aid, Brocton and Portland. *(One of the calls ended up as a rescue of 97 individuals from the Chautauqua Gorge.)
- <u>Two MVA's</u>: both in the Village a dump truck rollover at 33 Bourne Street; and a car into a fence at 14 Academy Street.
- One Service Call: power line arcing at 8750 Route 20.
