RE: Monthly Fire Department Report for April, 2015
DATE: May 1, 2015

Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 52 calls during the month of April. The breakdown is as follows:

- **Two Fire Calls:**
 - one in the Village – grease fire at 125 East Main Street; and
 - one on the NYS Thruway – brake fire on a tractor-trailer at mile marker 476.4 westbound.
- **Two MVA's:** both in the Town – car hit tree at Routes 5 and 394; and a motorcycle crash on Route 5 near KOA Kampground.
- **44 EMS Calls:** 25 in the Village; six in the Town; 12 at Absolut Care; and one mutual aid to Ripley.
- **Three Service Calls:** a tree down blocking the roadway near Edgewater; an injured dog rescue in the Chautauqua Gorge off 7783 Martin Wright Road; and a local transport from Westfield Memorial Hospital to Absolut Care.
- **One False Alarm:** a fire alarm activation at 7550 Hardenburg Road.
