RE: Monthly Fire Department Report for March, 2015

DATE: April 3, 2015

Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 58 calls during the month of March. The breakdown is as follows:

• Seven Fire Calls:

- four in the Village power lines arcing at North Gale and Oak Streets; wires arcing at Route 394 and South Gale Street; help to clear smoke from 25 Jefferson Street, Better Baked Foods; and a fire alarm activation (light ballast) at Westfield School; and
- three in the Town a partial structure collapse at 8273 First Street, Barcelona; a truck fire on Route 5; and a smoke investigation at 106 East Avenue, Forest Park.
- **<u>47 EMS Calls</u>**: 25 in the Village; six in the Town; and 16 at Absolut Care.
- **<u>Two Service Calls</u>**: one to secure the landing zone at Westfield Memorial Hospital; and a broken water pipe broke at 103 Chestnut Street.
- **<u>Two False Alarms</u>**: one fire alarm activation at 20 East Main Street, McClurg Museum; and one smoke detector activation at 138 East Main Street, Westfield Family Physicians.
