RE: Monthly Fire Department Report for March, 2015
DATE: April 3, 2015

Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 58 calls during the month of March. The breakdown is as follows:

- **Seven Fire Calls:**
 - four in the Village – power lines arcing at North Gale and Oak Streets; wires arcing at Route 394 and South Gale Street; help to clear smoke from 25 Jefferson Street, Better Baked Foods; and a fire alarm activation (light ballast) at Westfield School; and
 - three in the Town – a partial structure collapse at 8273 First Street, Barcelona; a truck fire on Route 5; and a smoke investigation at 106 East Avenue, Forest Park.

- **47 EMS Calls:** 25 in the Village; six in the Town; and 16 at Absolut Care.

- **Two Service Calls:** one to secure the landing zone at Westfield Memorial Hospital; and a broken water pipe broke at 103 Chestnut Street.

- **Two False Alarms:** one fire alarm activation at 20 East Main Street, McClurg Museum; and one smoke detector activation at 138 East Main Street, Westfield Family Physicians.
