RE: Monthly Fire Department Report for September, 2014
DATE: October 1, 2014

Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 57 calls during the month of September. The breakdown is as follows:

- **Seven Fire Calls:**
 - four in the Village – fire alarm activation at 40 South Portage Street, Patterson Library; two calls for oxygen system problems at 26 Cass Street, Absolut Care; and gasoline spill at 128 East Main Street, Crosby's;
 - one in the Town – lights flickering at 1911 Edgewater Drive; and
 - two Mutual Aid – house fire in Portland and trailer fire in Brocton.

- **One MVA:**
 - one in the Village – person struck by vehicle at 7578 Martin Wright Road.

- **44 EMS Calls:** 22 in the Village; eight in the Town; one on the NYS Thruway; and 13 at Absolut Care.

- **Three Service Calls:** secure landing zone at Westfield Memorial Hospital; limb burning on wires at 7688 Route 5; and wires down at 7540 Route 5, Bourne's Beach.

- **Two False Alarms:** one at Washington and Pearl Streets, VFW and a resident pulled the fire alarm at 26 Cass Street, Absolut Care.
