RE: Monthly Fire Department Report for August
DATE: October 15, 2017

Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 45 calls during the month of September. The breakdown is as follows:

- **Six Fire Calls:**
 - two in the Village – a detector activation at 112 North Portage, Growers' Co-op; and a fire alarm activation at 203 East Main Street, Westfield Academy and Central School;
 - one in the Town – odor of gas in the area of Route 20 and Munson Road;
 - one on the NYS Thruway – possible RV fire at mile marker 482 westbound; and
 - two for mutual aid – one to Portland and one to West Dunkirk.
- **One MVA:**
 - on the NYS Thruway – vehicle rollover at mile marker 477.5 westbound.
- **32 EMS Calls:** 18 in the Village, seven in the Town, two mutual aid calls to Ripley and five at Absolut Care.
- **Four Service Calls:** tree down across Route 5 near McKinley Road; tree blocking the road at Route 20 and Hardenburg Road; tree across the westbound lane at 155 East Main Street; and trees and wires down throughout Hawthorne Beach. These calls were all during a two-hour span of one night.
- **Two False Alarms:** one fire alarm activation at 40 South Portage Street, Patterson Library, which was due to a child pulling the alarm; and one fire alarm activation at Welch's Plant on North Portage, which was being investigated.
