VACCINATION GUIDELINES:

- ✓ New York State law requires that all cats, dogs, and domestic ferrets be vaccinated for rabies at age 3 months.
- ✓ A booster is required:
 - *One year after animal's first dose of rabies vaccine.
 - *Every 3 years thereafter.

REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ All animals must be accompanied by an adult.
- ✓ Dogs must be on a leash.
- ✓ Cats must be brought in a container (i.e. kennel, box, duffel bag).
- ✓ Know age and breed of animal.
- ✓ Know the name of the township where you live.
- ✓ Certificates will be provided to owners and town clerks.
- ✓ Bring only healthy animals.
- ✓ Bring your animal's previous vaccination record.

NOTES: ♦ Immunization records are kept by the Department of Health and Town Clerks only. Veterinarians administering shots *do not keep records.*

♦ *Unvaccinated dogs and cats, more than 3 months of age, which come into contact with rabid animals or are involved in bite incidents may have to be destroyed and/or may subject their owners to fines.*
