- Calls accepted Monday Thursday (9/28-10/1) 1:00-4:00.
- Provide your name, address, animal information.
- You'll be given an appointment time to arrive at the clinic.
- People & pets will stay in vehicles. Animal handlers will transport pets from vehicle to veterinarian for vaccination.
- **Facemasks** are required.
- NO walk-ins will be accepted.
- Bring previous vaccination record to the clinic to receive a 3 year vaccination.
- Certificates will be provided at the clinic.

CLINIC REQUIREMENTS

- Bring only healthy animals.
- Animals must be **3 months old** to receive first shot.
- Dogs must be on a leash, small dogs can be in carriers.
- Cats must be in a container (carrier, kennel, box, etc.).

- 1st booster required within one (1) year of first dose of rabies vaccine.
- 2nd booster required every 3 years after.
- Unvaccinated animals, more than 3 months of age, which are in contact with rabid animals or are involved in bite incidents, may have to be euthanized and/or their owners may be fined.
