Court Clerk Julie Devlin went over the Public Safety Security Assessment recommendations that was received by the Office of Court Administrations.

Councilman David Brown offered the following resolution and moved for its adoption

**Resolution No.69 of 2019
Town of Westfield
Authorize the Town Court to apply for a JCAP grant**

WHEREAS, the Town of Westfield Justice Court has had the Department of Public Safety Security Assessment for the Village and Town of Westfield Court Building, and

WHEREAS, the Court Building is also known as Eason Hall located at 23 Elm Street (Village & Town), and

WHEREAS, as a result of the Department of Public Safety Security Assessment prepared by the Office of Court Administrations dated June 17, 2019 and received by the Town & Village Court Clerk's Office on September 12, 2019, and

WHEREAS, the recommendations suggested in the Security Assessment prepared by the Office of Court Administrations for the Building of said Assessment, states, if funding permits; related recommendations to increase building security, and, as the Town Court is the tenant of the building the Town Court agrees to participate in a joint JCAP application with the Village of Westfield Court as the Town of Westfield Court is a tenant and the Village and Town Court share Court facilities and offices.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Westfield Court is hereby authorized to apply for a JCAP Grant during the 2019-2020 Grant Cycle in the amount not to exceed \$30,000.00.
